1. Introduction

By purchasing a class pass, registering for a class or event, attending one of our programs, or using our website, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions, our Student Policies, Privacy Policy, and Cookie Policy.

If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not use our services.

3. Definitions

For the purposes of these Terms:

Class

A regularly scheduled dance class offered by STU Arts Dance SRL.

Workshop

A special event or intensive offered separately from the regular class schedule.

Pass

A prepaid package of classes or workshops with a stated validity period.

Unlimited Pass

A membership allowing unlimited attendance within the applicable validity period, subject to the Student Policies.

Student

Any person participating in STU Arts Dance SRL classes, workshops, events, or services.

Website

www.stuartsdance.com and any associated online services operated by STU Arts Dance SRL.

4. Eligibility

Unless otherwise specified, STU Arts Dance SRL programs are intended for adults aged **18 years or older**.

Some workshops or events may have minimum age requirements, prerequisites, or recommended experience levels. These requirements will be clearly stated in the event description.

Participants are responsible for registering for classes appropriate to their level.

STU Arts Dance SRL reserves the right to recommend a different class where it believes another level would provide a safer or more appropriate learning experience.

5. Registration, Bookings & Payments

All registrations and bookings are managed through our booking platform, **Bsport**.

By registering for any class, workshop, event, membership, or pass, you agree to:

- provide accurate and complete information;
- keep your contact information up to date;
- comply with these Terms and our Student Policies;
- pay all applicable fees before participating unless otherwise agreed.

Accepted payment methods may include:

- Credit Card
- Bancontact
- Bank Transfer (where approved by STU Arts Dance SRL)

Prices are displayed in Euros (€) and may be updated periodically.

Price changes do not affect purchases completed before the change takes effect.

6. Class Schedule & Changes

STU Arts Dance SRL strives to deliver all advertised classes, workshops, instructors, and events.

However, we reserve the right to modify:

- class schedules;
- instructors;
- studio locations;
- course content;
- event programming;

where reasonably necessary.

Whenever possible, participants will be notified in advance.

We also reserve the right to cancel or combine classes due to insufficient enrollment, instructor illness, venue availability, or circumstances beyond our control.

Where a class or workshop is cancelled by STU Arts Dance SRL, affected participants will be offered an appropriate alternative, credit, or refund where applicable.

7. Participation & Health

Dance and physical activity involve inherent risks.

By participating, you confirm that:

- you are physically capable of participating;
- you will exercise reasonable care for your own health and safety;
- you have informed STU Arts Dance SRL of any injury, medical condition, or physical limitation that may affect your participation.

If you are unsure whether participation is appropriate, we recommend consulting a healthcare professional before attending.

Students participate at their own risk.

STU Arts Dance SRL cannot accept responsibility for injuries resulting from participation except where liability cannot legally be excluded under Belgian law.

8. Personal Belongings

Students are responsible for their own personal belongings at all times.

STU Arts Dance SRL is not liable for the loss, theft, or damage of personal items brought to classes, workshops, events, or other activities.

If personal belongings are found after a class or event, reasonable efforts will be made to return them to their owner. Unclaimed items may be handled in accordance with the policies of the venue where the activity takes place.

9. Photography & Videography

STU Arts Dance SRL may photograph or record classes, workshops, performances, community events, and other activities for promotional, educational, archival, or marketing purposes.

Where required by applicable law, participants will be informed in advance when photography or videography is taking place.

Students who do not wish to appear in close-up promotional photographs or videos should notify STU Arts Dance SRL before the start of the activity. We will make reasonable efforts to accommodate these requests; however, we cannot guarantee that individuals will not appear incidentally in group photographs or recordings taken during public classes, performances, or events.

By attending public performances, showcases, or community events, participants acknowledge that they may appear in crowd or group images used to document and promote STU Arts Dance SRL.

10. Intellectual Property

All choreography, teaching methods, class materials, written content, videos, photographs, graphics, branding, logos, and other original works created by STU Arts Dance SRL remain the intellectual property of STU Arts Dance SRL unless otherwise stated.

These materials may not be reproduced, copied, distributed, recorded for commercial purposes, taught publicly, or otherwise used without prior written permission.

Students may not record classes, workshops, or rehearsals without the express permission of the instructor or STU Arts Dance SRL.

Nothing in these Terms transfers ownership of any intellectual property rights to participants.

11. Student Conduct

STU Arts Dance SRL is committed to fostering a welcoming, respectful, and inclusive environment where everyone feels safe to learn, move, and express themselves.

Students are expected to:

- Treat fellow students, instructors, staff, and guests with courtesy and respect.
- Follow instructor directions and studio guidelines to help maintain a safe and positive learning environment.
- Respect the studio facilities, equipment, and shared spaces.
- Refrain from disruptive, abusive, discriminatory, intimidating, or threatening behaviour.
- Contribute to an environment that supports learning and community.

STU Arts Dance SRL reserves the right to refuse participation, remove a participant from a class or event, or terminate a student's enrollment without refund if their behaviour compromises the safety, wellbeing, or experience of others or repeatedly violates these policies.

12. Accessibility & Inclusion

STU Arts Dance SRL believes dance should be as accessible and welcoming as possible.

If you have an injury, disability, medical condition, or require a reasonable accommodation to participate, we encourage you to contact us before attending. While we cannot guarantee that every accommodation is possible, we will make reasonable efforts to support your participation whenever feasible.

Participants are responsible for informing instructors of any relevant medical conditions or injuries that may affect their ability to safely participate.

13. Privacy & Data Protection

STU Arts Dance SRL respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data.

We process personal information in accordance with applicable data protection laws, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

14. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by Belgian law, STU Arts Dance SRL shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or punitive damages arising from participation in our classes, workshops, events, performances, private lessons, or the use of our website or services.

Nothing in these Terms excludes or limits liability where such exclusion or limitation is prohibited under applicable law.

Participants acknowledge that dance and physical activity involve inherent risks and accept responsibility for participating within their own physical abilities.

15. Force Majeure

STU Arts Dance SRL shall not be held responsible for any delay, interruption, or failure to perform its obligations where such delay or failure results from circumstances beyond our reasonable control.

These circumstances may include, but are not limited to:

- Natural disasters
- Fire or flood
- Pandemic or epidemic
- Government restrictions or public health measures
- War, terrorism, or civil unrest
- Power outages or utility failures
- Labour disputes
- Instructor illness
- Venue closures
- Other unforeseen events beyond our reasonable control

Where reasonably possible, affected classes or events will be rescheduled or appropriate alternatives will be offered.

16. Student Policies

The STU Arts Dance SRL **Student Policies** form part of these Terms & Conditions.

By registering for any class, workshop, event, membership, or service, you agree to comply with both these Terms & Conditions and the Student Policies.

If there is any inconsistency between these Terms & Conditions and the Student Policies, these Terms & Conditions shall prevail.

17. Severability

If any provision of these Terms & Conditions is found to be unlawful, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

18. Governing Law

These Terms & Conditions shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Belgium.

Any dispute arising from these Terms or your use of our services shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Belgium.

19. Changes to these Terms

STU Arts Dance SRL reserves the right to amend or update these Terms & Conditions from time to time.
